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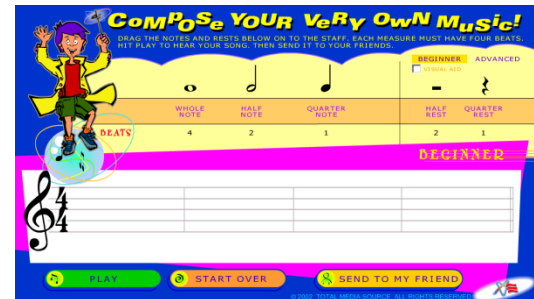
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This Month's New Resources

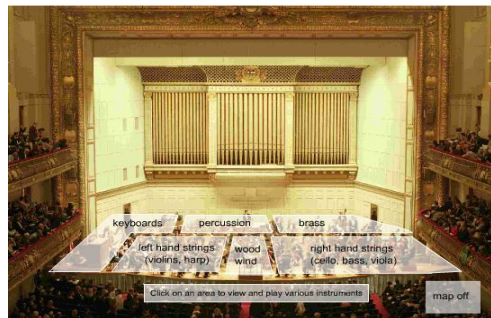
Sing for joy! Music resources have arrived! 142 new music resources were added to our search section this month. Resources are grouped in eight categories: Composers; Composing and Performing; Identifying Instruments; Melody and Pitch; Online Songs; Reading Music; Rhythm and Tempo; and Science of Sound.

To access these resources, login to your teacher account and click on the resources tab. Then, click on the "Search for resources by grade, subject and topic" button. Select a Grade. Then select Music as your subject. Narrow your search results by selecting a topic group.

Students can compose their very own music by dragging notes to the staff. They can listen to their compositions and send them to friends.



Zoom in to view sections of the virtual orchestra. Learn about each instrument and listen to it played online.



Learn about musical symbols by dragging each to the staff and listening to how it changes the music.

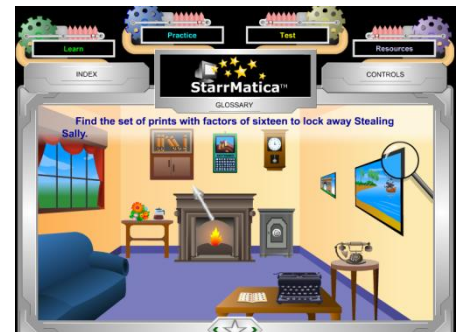
