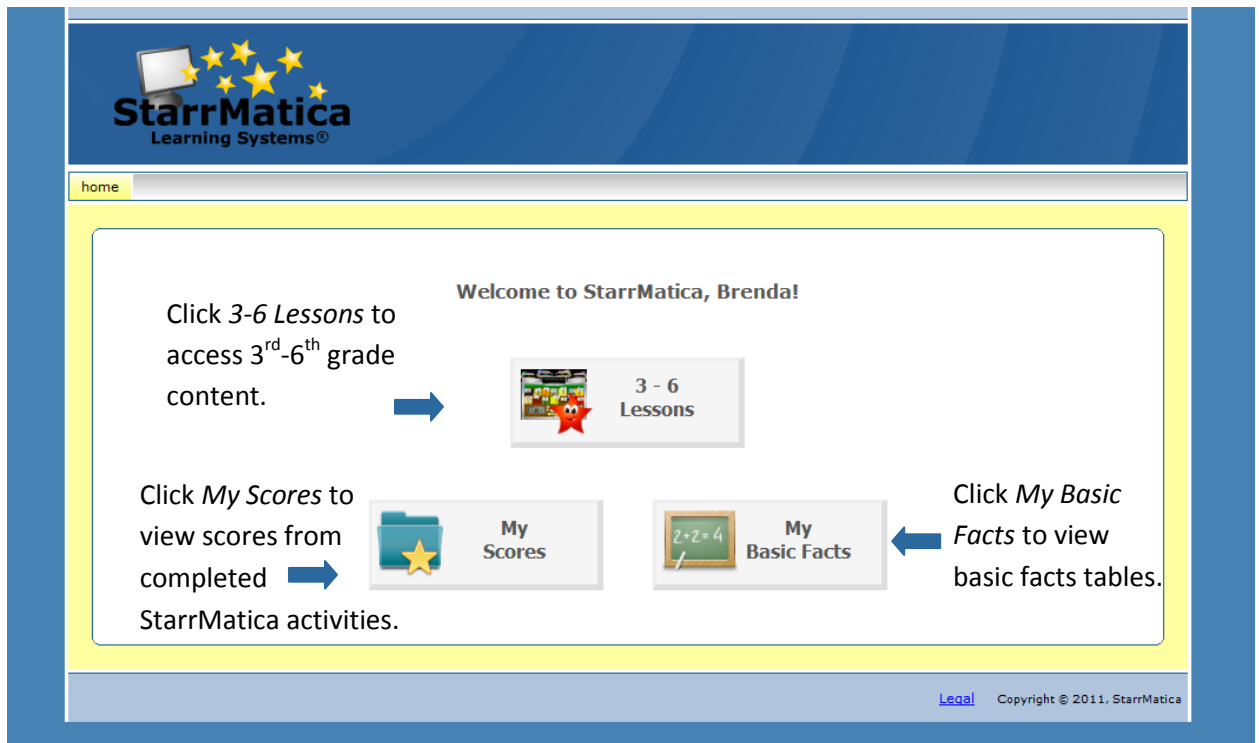

Classroom Management 2.0 is here!!!

The past six months, StarrMatica's classroom management system was completely redesigned. We have made changes to help you more easily and effectively navigate the system, share content with students, and track student progress. Tomorrow, **a link will appear below** your Scores and Passwords button that says: *Try out the NEW progress account features* (You can see the link on page 1 of this newsletter.) Simply click the link to enjoy all of the features of the new system.

Not ready to switch? Click your Scores and Passwords button to access the OLD classroom management system. The new system will become your main button automatically in one month, but you will be able to click a link to revert back to the old system until June 1, 2012. On the following page is a sneak peek of the new features you can take advantage of tomorrow!

Favorite Content

In *Links*, teachers have the opportunity to search our entire library of content and add content to their favorites. These favorites will make it easier for you to quickly locate your favorite content and to save those favorites from year to year.

Create and Share Collections

In *Share*, teachers have the ability to create collections of content. Maybe you want to create a collection for a specific unit or lesson or maybe you want to create a collection for a specific student. Once you have created a collection, you have the ability to share that collection with a single student, a group of students, or your entire class! When students login they are shown a “My Collections” button. If you have shared a new collection since the last time a student visited “My Collections,” the backpack will be full. A student can click the backpack and see the collection you have shared. Imagine students logging in at home and their parents knowing what content their child should be accessing. Imagine taking a whole class into a computer lab and having each student sit down and automatically go to content that has been selected to fit their individual needs. Collections can also be saved from year to year!



Color Coded Percentage Scores

Percentage scores are color coded so teachers can identify strengths and weaknesses at a glance. The default scale is: pink shading for 59% and below, yellow shading for 60%-89%, green shading for 90% and above. You can even customize your colored percentage scale to match your standardized testing proficiency percentages or your district’s grading scale.

Add Test Scores

For all tests, a C is displayed when the student has completed the test and has pressed the DONE button at the bottom of the printable assessment. Now, after you have used our handy answer key to correct the assessment, you can manually enter a test score so students and their parents can see test results.

Class or Group Basic Facts

When you have chosen to view class or group scores and you select basic facts and a specific operation, a list of those facts is displayed. This view allows teachers at a glance to determine common missed facts for an entire class. + and – indicate correct and incorrect facts and the green row below the list of facts displays the percentage of students in the class that have mastered each fact.

Student Basic Facts

When you have chosen to view student scores and you select basic facts and a specific operation, two facts tables are displayed. The first table displays a student's current facts knowledge. This table changes based on a student's performance during the facts practice activity in the practice section. The second table displays a student's facts knowledge as determined by the benchmark test. This table does not change until a student completes the benchmark test again.

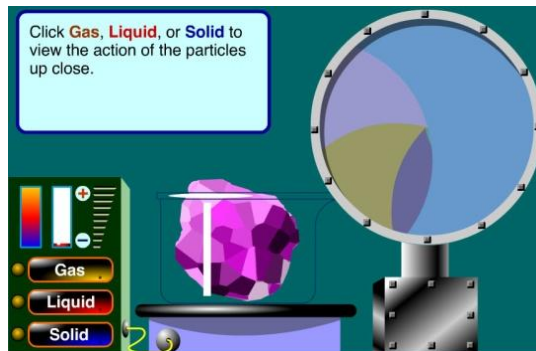
