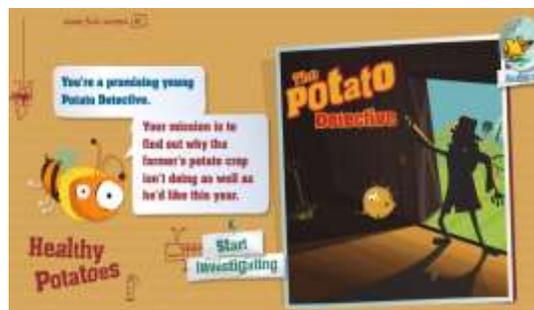
### *Sound Search*

## Teacher Feature: Billy Strickler

Meet Billy Strickler. He is in his 8<sup>th</sup> year of teaching 4<sup>th</sup> grade students at Washington Elementary in Fairfield, Iowa. Billy has a great group of 19 students this year. 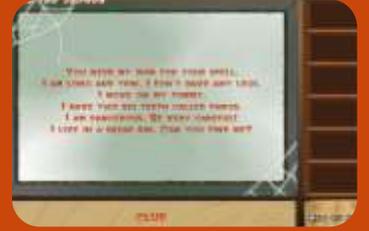
